Dear Students and Families,

Congratulations on completing first grade! In order to prepare for the upcoming school year, we recommend that children read, or have someone read to them, as often as possible during the summer months. In fact, research is clear that children who don't read during the summer can lose up to three months of reading progress and that loss has a cumulative, long-term effect.

We recommend that you refer to the suggested reading choice list attached if you are looking for some good titles. Although choosing titles from this list is not mandatory, it would be a good place to turn to for ideas. The goal will be to read ten books and record these on the tracking sheet over the summer. If your child reads ten titles and returns the completed tracking form, he/she will earn a special dining experience in September. The children will sit at a lovely decorated cafeteria table with their very own teacher. The children will eat their regular school bought or home packed lunch at this dining experience.

Return your tracking sheet to your second grade teacher by Friday, September 6, 2019. We look forward to working with your child next year at Naquag. Have a great summer!
